2. Amazon is reportedly in serious talks to open its HQ2 in Crystal City, which has easy transit access and ready-to-occupy office buildings. What city and state is Amazon looking to make their HQ2? (MAIN)
3. Mayor Jenny Durkan's recently released budget proposal calls for about \$\_\_\_\_\_ million in spending on homelessness in 2019, and Seattle's City Council is looking to add more. (MAIN)
4. Amazon's Spheres in downtown Seattle are among the buildings and structures in the region bathed in blue light to honor Paul Allen. The idea originated with Seahawks fans who wanted to show their support for the Allen family. The tribute began at dusk Saturday and continues through midnight Sunday. Who was Paul Allen? (NW SUNDAY)

6. Oregon is one of just a handful of states without a sales tax, and voters have repeatedly rejected attempts to add one. This election, a ballot measure asks voters to enshrine that opposition in the state constitution — at least, when it comes to what? What would Measure 103 ban? (NW SUNDAY)
7. As Seattle area keeps building hotels, there soon may be too much room at the inn. How the industry will deal with up to 4,000 new rooms is far from certain. Hotel demand in Seattle remains remarkably strong, thanks to what two things? (NW SUNDAY)
8. Early last week the news was that the average Seattle-area homebuyer has been successfully able to negotiate a deal at below list price for the first time in four years. But that's only half the story: In a lot of cases, sellers are now doing the work for buyers by doing what? (BUSINESS)

4. He was the Microsoft co-founder, philanthropist and Seahawks owner who died last month. (NW SUNDAY, B1)
5. I-1639 would raise the legal age to buy any semi-automatic rifle to 21, from 18. People wanting one would have to pass an enhanced background check, show proof they have taken a firearms-training course, and wait 10 business days before they take possession of the weapon. (NW SUNDAY, B1)
6. Groceries; Lawmakers from imposing any future taxes or fees on the sale or distribution of groceries and nonalcoholic beverages. (NW SUNDAY, B2)
7. Robust growth in tourism and business travel (BUSINESS, D1)
8. Lowering the list price themselves (BUSINESS, D1)
9. That's largely because your body has been fasting all night and needs refueling, but also because skipping breakfast shifts more calories to later in the day.
